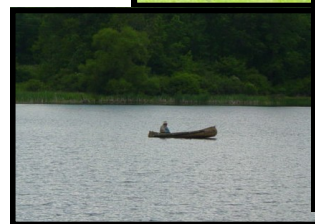
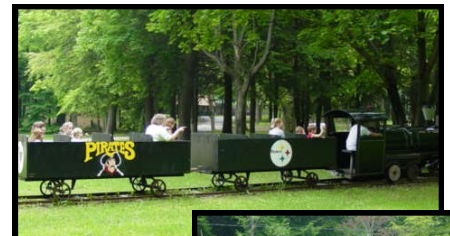

Rules and Regulations

1. Pavilions are open to the public on May 15th and closes September 15th.
2. Reserved Pavilions hours are from 10:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m., seven days a week.
3. Beer is the only alcoholic beverage permitted.
4. Pets are permitted within recreation areas provided they are on a leash and attended at all times. Patrons are responsible to clean up after their pets.
5. Consideration of other park users is essential.
6. The park provides a waste receptacle for refuse accumulated during your stay. Please place all waste in the dumpster prior to vacating your site.
7. Unorganized or organized instruction, exhibition, competition, demonstrations, or special events first require written application and approval from the Park Director.

THE FOLLOWING IS STRICTLY PROHIBITED AT THE PARK:

1. Underage drinking and public intoxication.
2. Boisterous, immoral, or indecent conduct will not be tolerated.
3. Solicitation of any kind or posting of signs.
4. The distribution, sales, servicing, or rental of any supplies, equipment, materials, or commodity is restricted.
5. Hunting and trapping is prohibited. Discharge of firearms, archery equipment, slingshots, projectiles, or explosives is prohibited.
6. The use of any electric generator causing unreasonable or excessive noise is prohibited.

Pavilion Rates/Size and Holding Capacity

All pavilions have electricity, horseshoe pits and water spigots.

Six small pavilions #5, 6,7,8,11,13 (accommodates 50-60 persons) - \$50.00

Five medium pavilions #1,3,4,12,14 (accommodates 60-80 persons) - \$55.00

Two large pavilions # 9,10 (accommodates 80-150 persons) - \$65.00

X-large pavilion # 2 (accommodates 150-220 persons) - \$70.00

FYI—Volleyball courts are located near Pavilions #1 & 2, 3 & 4, and 8 & 9

For a small fee you can rent sports equipment such as:

Volleyball net and balls, basketball, horseshoes, etc.

Pavilion Reservations

1. Reservations will be taken by mail, phone or in person at the County Operations office, at (814) 472-8514.
2. Reservations must be made by completing and submitting this application.
3. As stated on the application: **Payment in full must accompany the application.**
4. A reservation can be requested by phone. We will hold the request for five (5) days from initial request. If payment is not received within five (5) days, the hold is automatically be rescinded.
5. During their visit, patrons who reserved a shelter will have the opportunity to reserve the same pavilion, on the same day of the same week for the following season. (Example: 2nd Saturday of June or 3rd Sunday of July.)
6. The name under which the reservation was made or a copy of thereservation must accompany the application.
7. Reservations for new patrons and those wishing to reserve a different pavilion or change the date reserved will not be accepted until at least one week after the corresponding date.

Cancellation Policy

Cancellations made with at least 30 days notice will receive 100% refund. Within 14 days, patrons will receive a 50% refund. **No refunds for cancellations made with less than 14 days notice.**

***No refunds for inclement weather.**
